The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) and the Attorney General have enclosed the subject report for your review and consideration. The report is a culmination of over two months of community meetings, briefings and other outreach efforts to inform the public about the Settlement Agreement and proposed legislation, solicit input and questions, and provide recommendations back to the Legislature for its consideration in decision making.


We continue to believe that the Settlement Agreement and proposed legislation are fair and just resolution to the 30-year dispute regarding the income and proceeds due to OHA from the Public Land Trust. We continue to believe that this is the right time for resolution, and that given past history and present economic conditions, the more time that passes without resolution, the less likely that fair resolution becomes.

OHA and the Attorney General continue to remain available in the remaining weeks of this legislative session to respond to any of the points raised in this report or any other questions the Legislature may have regarding the Settlement Agreement or proposed legislation.


